FUEL SURCHARGE

Skywest, the Australian and South East Asia regional airline operator, announces that it will be making changes to its surcharges due to the increasing costs of operations.

Effective 1 March 2008, the fuel levy surcharge will increase to AUD27 (plus Government Sales Tax) for routes operated by turbo-prop aircraft, and AUD29 (plus GST) for jet operated routes. This unavoidable increase follows sharp increases in world crude oil prices that have in turn impacted Skywest's base fuel costs.

Also effective from the 22nd of February 2008, credit card surcharges will increase to AUD3 per passenger per sector.

Commenting on this policy Paul Daff, CEO Skywest, said:

"I am reluctant to make these changes, however Skywest can no longer continue to absorb the significant increases in world fuel prices. Any changes are made with the underlying objective to keep Skywest airfares affordable and competitive. These increases are consistent with other airlines operating in Australia which increased fuel surcharges in late 2007 and early 2008."
