LARGE NETWORK EXPANSION

Skywest, the Australian and South East Asia regional airline, is pleased to announce an expansion of its network. Skywest advises that it is increasing capacity between Perth and Western Australian regional destinations of Exmouth, Geraldton and Albany. Skywest is to resume services to the town of Karratha.. All of these expansion initiatives occur with effect from 26th May 2008. This is the largest increase in the network for several years.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Resumption of twice weekly Perth-Karratha services operated by 100 seat jets;
- Increase in Perth-Geraldton services from 37 to 40 flights per week, representing an 8% increase in capacity;
- Increase in Perth-Albany services from 18 to 20 flights per week, representing a 10% increase in capacity;
- Upgrading three services per week to Exmouth to a jet service which represents a 14% increase in capacity; and
- Skywest further advises that the fuel levy charged on passenger tickets is under review with a further increase possible in the near term.

Jeff Chatfield, Executive Chairman of Skywest said: **"We are delighted that demand for our services has been so strong. With the market continuing to grow and the resource – mining sector of Western Australia remaining a key driver, these additional services will further boost our offering."**
