NOVEMBER 2008 AIRLINE PASSENGER OPERATING STATISTICS

Charter services increase by 112.50% to 221

Skywest, the Australian and South East Asia regional airline, is pleased to announce airline network operating statistics for the month of November 2008, showing a 112.50% increase in scheduled charter services – rising to 221 from 104 in November 2007.

Following the acquisition of additional aircraft to satisfy its charter service contracts, Skywest is able to sell a larger number of seats to paying passengers, with capacity measured by Available Seat Kilometres (ASKs) increased by 5.65% over the same period.

The number of passengers carried during the month decreased by 13.20% over the previous year. Skywest traffic, measured by Revenue Passenger Kilometres (RPKs) decreased by 1.36%. Load factor, which does not include Charter Passengers decreased by 3.76% to 52.97% compared to the previous year.

Jeff Chatfield, Executive Chairman of Skywest said:

“The fact that our charter service is performing well is testament to the success of our ability to be an integral part of the Western Australian natural resources sector. We have a number of contracts with some of the World’s largest miners, which has allowed us to expand our fleet and the scale of the operation.”
